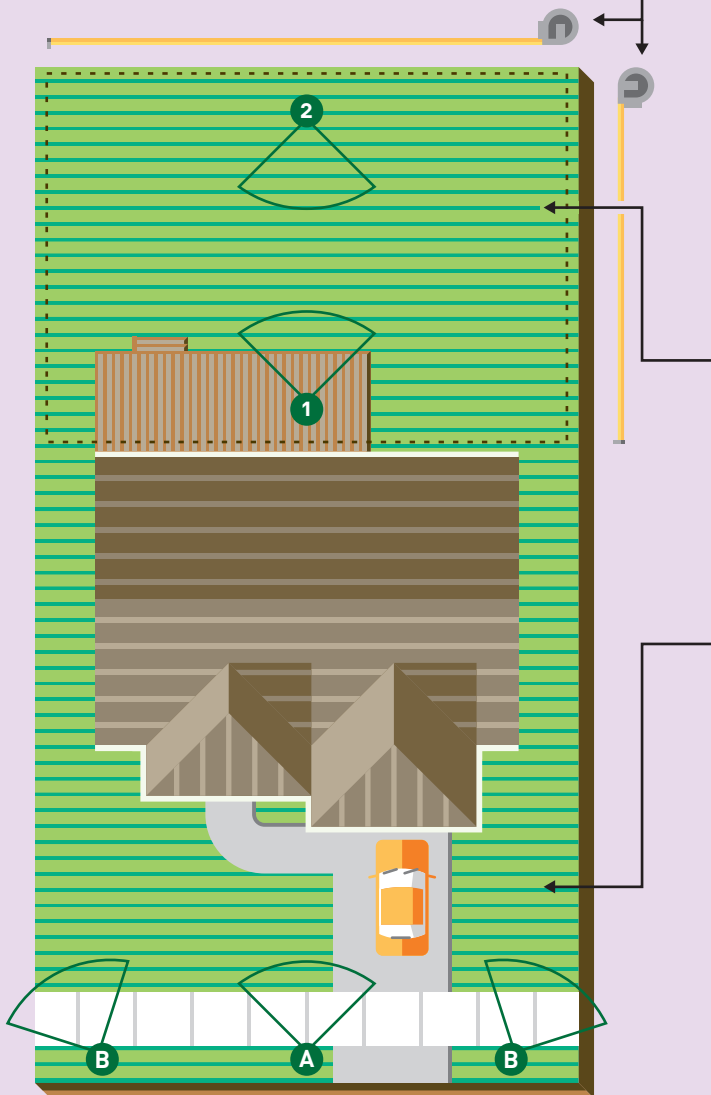


A BRIEF GUIDE TO OUR PROCESS

PREPARING FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT

Before your first appointment you will need to gather some easy information regarding your home and the area to be landscaped.



YOU WILL NEED:

Dimensions

First we ask that you know the dimensions of the area to be worked with. Bring with you a COPY of your lot survey. If this isn't available, simply walk off the area and keep track of the distance in approximate feet.

The dimensions need not be exact, we only ask for an estimate with regards to the available space.

Pictures

No matter the number of areas you would like landscaped, a picture really is worth a thousand words to us.

FOR THE BACKYARD:

- 1 Take a couple of pictures from the back of the house into the yard.
- 2 Take a couple of photos from the back of the property showing the house.

- ! Take four to five additional pictures from various angles.

FOR THE FRONT YARD:

- A Take a few pictures of the whole property from the street.
- B Take a couple of photos that include the neighbours on both sides.

- ! Take four to five additional pictures from various angles.

Please bring a hard copy of your pictures for reference. They need not be high quality: using a home printer is more than enough.

DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT

During your appointment at our garden centre, we will proceed to sketch proposals of what direction your garden(s) will take.

While sketching, we can discuss your likes and dislikes. These can range from varieties of plants to the colours that will appear in the final design.
